100% red Grenache on stony red clay soils

Traditional vinification, destemming and vating of  
the whole grapes without crushing

**PRODUCTION**

127 cases

This 100 years old vineyard is located in the upper part of the Iregua riverbank and of the foothills of Islallana.

This 0.68 hectares of Grenache grapes were planted in 1930 in this area known as “Caracuesta”.

After the grapes are manually harvested, they are almost entirely destemmed, except for 10% of it that is kept as whole clusters.

Then begins the spontaneous fermentation on indigenous yeasts for 17 days with small daily pump-overs.

After a year in tank, the wine was raked into two new barrels and four second-use French oak barrels were it was aged  
for 18 months. Only 1,520 bottles were obtained from this 2018 vintage.
